Uniform and Equipment Contract 2022-2023

All marching band uniforms and equipment are the property of Council Rock High School South. The “Uniform & Equipment Maintenance Fee” paid by each marching band member includes the use of the uniform and its accessories, equipment, and related items during the 2022-2023 year in addition to normal uniform cleaning and maintenance.

It is the responsibility of each student to properly care for the uniform, accessories, equipment, and related items. Individual students will be required to pay for the repair and/or replacement of the uniform, accessories, equipment, or related items in case of loss or damage.

I, _____, and my parent(s) / guardian(s) understand that I am solely responsible for any and all parts of the uniform and equipment issued by the Council Rock South Marching Band. I understand that if any parts of the uniform, accessories, equipment, or related items are lost or damaged, I will assume total responsibility for all repair or replacement costs. I understand that the *estimated* costs are as follows:

Additionally, I and my parent(s) / guardian(s) understand the uniform guidelines established by Council Rock South Marching Band:

- I must purchase the **required marching or color guard shoes**. I will keep these clean and free of mud. I will **also label the inside** of each shoe with my name.
- If I am a musician, I must also purchase **solid black socks which rise at least to my calf**. These socks will always be worn with my uniform.
- I must purchase the **required blue marching band t-shirt**. If I am a musician, I will always wear this shirt under my jacket. I may wear it over a band sweatshirt, or Under Armor – type shirt. I understand that sleeveless tops and colorful shirts are not permitted, as sleeveless shirts will allow perspiration stains to occur on the jacket, and colorful shirts may bleed or be seen through the jacket.
- To prevent damage / staining, I will **not eat or drink anything (other than water) when in full uniform** unless directed by a staff member.
- I will not allow my uniform to come in contact with antistatic spray, spot cleaning chemicals, bleaches, spray deodorants, perfumes, make up, or hair care products such as hair gel and hair spray.
- I will **never wash, iron, or make alterations** to any part of my uniform. If my uniform becomes dirty or damaged I will immediately bring it to the attention of one of the members of the (band parent) Uniform Committee.

- If I am required to wear a shako, **all of my hair will be under the shako**, and my hair will not touch the collar of the jacket. I will also **refrain from using hair gel or hair spray**, as it can damage the shako.
- If I am a horn player, I will **purchase the required gloves**. I will keep these clean by laundering them on my own as needed.
- I will treat my uniform with respect. This means taking it on and off with care, hanging it up properly, and not laying it down on floors or sidewalks.
- After performances, all parts of my uniform will be checked in with the marching band officers. My uniform jacket and bibbers will be **HUNG PROPERLY** on their hanger, and placed into their garment bag. My shako and plume will be stored properly in the case. **My uniform will NEVER be taken home**, except in special circumstances as determined by the Marching Band Director.

The Council Rock Band Parents Association –South (CRBPAS) is an organization of parents dedicated to making the marching band experience one of the most rewarding activities of your child’s high school career. **The \$160.00 membership fee** is used to enhance your child’s band experience in many ways, such as the annual picnic, the annual banquet, Friday night and Saturday meals during band season, scholarships, senior recognition, and numerous other activities.

CRBPAS has many active volunteer committees. The hard work and tireless efforts of our many volunteers allows us to provide refreshments following each performance, chaperones for band buses, facilities and equipment management, a pasta dinner, and a number of other supportive activities. Membership in CRBPAS also provides you with voting rights in the election of CRBPAS officers. Additionally, each family will have access to the marching band directory.



CRBPAS Volunteer Commitment

It takes an army to make our well oiled parents association work. In order to lighten the load, our organization requires a minimum of ten (10) volunteer hours per season, per family. Additionally, six (6) of these hours must be completed during our February/March fundraising competitions. To ensure that all families participate, a monetary deposit is required. Please know that your time is very valuable to CRBPAS. We would much rather have your presence than your money!

Procedure:

- Families will issue a deposit check of \$100 at membership night. This deposit demonstrates a family's commitment to contributing their valuable time to their child and our association.
- Checks must be made payable to CRBPAS and post dated for April 15, 2023.
- Checks will be placed in a sealed envelope which each member will self address.
- All checks will be given to the treasurer to hold. The deposit checks will be held (not cashed) by CRBPAS pending fulfillment of hours.
- All minimum required hours must be fulfilled by April 15, 2023.
 - hours given in excess of the minimum requirement cannot be carried over to the next season. Nor can the extra hours be "gifted" to another family experiencing an hours deficit.
- When all required volunteer hours have been fulfilled, checks will be returned in person at the March and April CRBPAS meetings. If you are unable to attend, the check will be mailed to you after April 15, 2023.
- Families who meet the volunteer commitment may also consider donating their \$100 back to the organization.
- Families who do not meet the required 10 volunteer hours in full will forfeit the volunteer deposit and their check will be cashed. No partial refunds will be made. You will receive written notification from CRBPAS before your check is cashed.



Responsibilities:

- Each member's parent or guardian is responsible for providing a specific number of volunteer hours during designated events throughout the season. Volunteer hours will be tracked through the Sign Up Genius links. Please be sure to use this site when volunteering!
- There are many ways to help:
 - Chaperone games or competitions
 - Help with equipment on/off the truck and field
 - Help with feeding the students on Fridays or Saturdays
 - Run concessions at concerts
 - Help with fundraising events
 - Join a committee or become a member of the Eboard
- ALL families must volunteer a minimum of 6* of their 10 hours during our main fundraising events in February and/or March: SpinOut at the Rock and WGI Regionals.
 - *If only one event is hosted, this minimum will drop to 4 hours.
- Remember that hours are per family. Those with multiple students in the band will only need a total of 10 hours. Likewise, if more than one adult in your family participates, all hours will be counted. Example- Mom and Grandmom work concessions for 3 hours at Spin Out, your family satisfies 6 volunteer hours!
